OUR LOSS NEAR CHATTANOOGA.

Saltus, the reliable correspondent of the Richmond Dispatch, reports loss in killed, wounded and missing at Lookout mountain, Missionary Ridge and Ringgold as follows: Killed, 323; wounded, 1,096; Missing, 2,319—total, 4,418. He adds:

"Since the subject was alluded to in the public prints, it will not be amiss to say that Major Nocquet, of the Engineer Department, deserted from this army five days before the late battle, and took with him about \$100,000 of Government funds, which he left; and that Capt. Meister, a dragoon in the same department, deserted some time previous to the battle of Chickamauga. Nocquet is said to be a Frenchman, and Meister a German Swiss. It is believed that Grant was induced to make the attack as soon as he did by the information furnished him by Nocquet."

G'en'l Halleck reports their (the enemy's) loss in killed, wounded and missing at about 4,000, and claim to have captured 6,000, prisoners besides the wounded left in their hands, forty pieces of artillery, five or six thousand small arms and a large train.
