That jumble of fog ends of factions, which, after disgracing and dropping all the numerous names it heretofore assumed, now very appropriately calls itself the "Opposition," is as hard to please as any "bear with a sore head" ever was.

If they were honest when they avowed Know Nothing sentiments, they must hold those sentiments still, however they might conceal them; and if they were not honest as Know Nothings, how could they be honest in anything else?
