Wish to say a few words to "whom it may concern" on the use of the swing— one of the gymnastic exercises— as a preventive and cure of pleurodynia disease. I mean that suspending of the body by the hands by means of a strong rope or chain fastened to a beam at one end and at the other a stick three feet long, convenient to grasp with the hands. The rope should be fastened to the centre of the stick, which should hang six or eight inches above the head. Let a person grasp this stick, and swing very moderately at first—perhaps only bear the weight if very weak—and gradually increase as the muscles gain strength from the exercise until it may be freely used from three to five times daily. The connexion of the arms with the body (with the exception of the clavicle with the sternum or breast bone) being a muscular attachment to the rib, the effect of this exercise is to elevate the ribs and enlarge the chest; and as nature allows no vacuum, the lungs expand to fill the cavity, increasing the volume of air—the natural purifier of the blood—and preventing coagulation or the deposit of tuberculous matter. I have prescribed the above for all cases of bronchitis of the lungs and threatened consumption for thirty five years, and have been able to increase the measure of the chest from two to four inches within a few months, and always with good results. But especially so preventive I would recommend this exercise. Let those who love life cultivate a well-ordered, copious chest. The student, the mechanic, the ordinary, the young of both sexes—i.e., all should have a strong upon which to stretch themselves daily, and I am morally certain that if this were to be practised by the rising generation, in a town offering a free and full development of the body, thousands of young men, thousands would be saved from the ravages of
