



LETTER FROM WASHINGTON.

WASHINGTON, April 29, 1861. The inhabitants of this city feel a greater sense of security to-day than they felt a week ago. There are not far from twenty thousand troops here, and before the close of the week the number will in all likelihood be increased to thirty thousand. No trouble would be found in quartering fifty thousand without and on warding in the numerous and spacious public and private buildings at the command of the government. Permanent residences have experienced no inconvenience whatever from the presence of this large number of armed soldiers. Perfect order is preserved, and since the death of the States newspaper, which happened early last week, not a word is heard about "outrage by a leading military."

GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE.

REQUITTES CHARLES, Harrisburg, April 30, '61. To the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania: GENTLEMEN:—The present unparalleled exigency in the affairs of our country, has induced me to call you together at this time. With an actual and armed rebellion in some of the States of the Union, momentous questions have been thrust upon us which call for your deliberation, and that you should devise means by legislation for the maintenance of the authority of the General Government, the honor and dignity of our State, the protection of our citizens, and the early establishment of peace and order throughout the land.

Gen. Sherman's arrest. Legal officers of the United States Army new in this city, under the command of the military of Gen. Sherman explained that: Sherman having been for Washington, he provided himself with a strong token by the Pennsylvania Railroad route, to Philadelphia. But as he has not started, a stranger, who is supposed to have been a secessionist in the plot for his capture, asked him in a friendly manner to show him his ticket. On looking at it he expressed surprise that the General should take that route, telling him that the railroad was torn up in rebellion to the Government. At the same time, he offered him in exchange a ticket on the Baltimore and Ohio road, and the General, without reflecting on the matter, accepted it. Doubt on the occasion then telegraphed to Harper's Ferry, and the Virginia were then on the lookout for the train that was drawn by their own, and they exactly when to get past him.

Union Resolutions.

LETTER FROM WASHINGTON.

After all it seems that Maryland will disappoint the disunionists. It did look ten days ago as if she meant to go out. But the sober second thought has come upon her already and her continuance in the Union is not to be doubted. If she remains faithful to her federal obligations to the end, her fidelity ought to be rewarded by any guarantee she may demand for the security of her property in slaves.

Let me give you Chambersburg people a hint which you may, if you have public spirit enough, turn to very useful account. Such an interruption to the transportation of troops and munitions of war for the defence of the capital as occurred at Baltimore, might under some circumstances prove fatal to the government.

Now get out your map and follow the line I shall run, beginning at this city. A railroad route has been surveyed from Washington to Frederick, Md., and a company incorporated to build the road. A little assistance from the government would soon put it through.

Do you not see clearly how much such a road would contribute to the security of the National Capitol? Troops from Eastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey and the Eastern part of New York, could be run into Harrisburg over the Pennsylvania Central, Lebanon, Reading and Eastern roads...

Let me give you another hint. The government Army at Harper's Ferry is broken up. It is said one will be established at Rock Island, Illinois. We shall then have one at the East (Springfield, Mass.) and one at the West. Why not also one in the Middle, and that at Chambersburg, where Pennsylvanians and New Yorkers flying to the defence of the National Capital could pick up arms as they went?

THE limits into which this letter must be compressed will not permit me to enlarge upon these topics. All I can add now is, that I hope the citizens of Chambersburg will bring these matters to the immediate attention of the government. This looks so me like the best chance they ever had or ever will have to do something handsome for Chambersburg and Franklin county. Start the ball and see how far you can roll it. But don't go about it casually, as if it made no difference whether you succeeded or not. Go at it in earnest—go at it bravely, and put it through to the tune of... YAKERS DOODLE.

WASHINGTON, May 8. The twenty days grace to the rebels have expired. Two regiments, with the Boston Flying Artillery, left Annapolis this morning by order of General Butler, and proceeded to the Relay House to hold that position. It is the junction of the Baltimore and Ohio, and Washington Railroad, and within eight miles of Baltimore. All the cars from Harper's Ferry must pass this point to reach Baltimore.

Have you heard that Washington city is going to be captured now very shortly? The Raleigh Register says so. It says "North Carolina has spoken and will do it," and therefore it will be done in double quick time. Now if North Carolina pine trees were rifled cannon, and North Carolina sand was powder, and the heads of North Carolina niggers would do for cannon balls; and if North Carolina had white men enough to shovel up the sand and cut off the nigger heads and shoot them out of the rifled pipes, there might be something in this threat.
