Affairs at Richmond.

From the very scanty reports that have been received concerning the operations of our army before Richmond we are led to believe that there is no making that progress in our advance to the rebel Capital that we hoped to chronicle this week. There has been some stirring times in the army, and any amount of heavy fighting within the past few days. The Pennsylvania Reserves have fought hard and lost largely. Rumor says that Gen McCLELLAN has retired from White House and has his army on the James River under protection of the Government. This may be a strategic one on the part of General McCLELLAN by which he will have Richmond entirely at his mercy. We hope this may be so, but being only a newspaper General we venture no opinion. The War Department has decided that no account of the fighting or movements are to be made public present. In a few days we trust this embargo on news will be taken off and that we shall receive all the particulars giving an account of the glorious victory and fall of the Rebel Capital. Among the list of killed in the recent engagements are the names of Col. Sam. Black of Pittsburg, and Col. Switzer, of Gen. McClellan's staff, Maj. Patterson, of the 82nd Pennsylvania, Col. Graves of the 22nd Massachusetts and Col. Roberts, of the 1st Michigan.
